- **Who?**  
All English majors and minors.
- **Why?**  
Read and discuss materials of common interest with your peers to enhance your classroom experiences.
- **What?**  
Reading group topics may include a single theoretical or literary text, a series of works by a single author, a series of essays on a particular topic, or a textbook related to literary study or creative writing, among other possibilities.
- **When?**  
To be determined by students in collaboration with the Department Coordinator.
- **Where?**  
English Department or other spaces as desired.

To apply, submit a proposal of approximately 250 words to Jan Beebe, the English Department Coordinator, at [englishdepartment@macalester.edu](mailto:englishdepartment@macalester.edu). Your proposal should describe the topic and aim of your reading group, a list of expenses such as honorarium and books, and when you plan to meet. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year, but priority will be given to those received by October 15th in the Fall and February 15th in the Spring.
